



FERAL CLINIC VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

Looking for volunteers for our Monterey County feral cat clinics. Clinics are fast paced, requires great teamwork & ability to work with a lot of different people. Clinic days can be long & physically demanding. Volunteers must be able to lift up to 20lbs, to & from a table height, as well as carry 20lbs for forty feet or more.

Volunteer Duties Include:

Cat intake: filling out descriptions on medical paperwork, labeling all traps and towels and numbering paperwork, traps and towels.

Cat trap wrangling: moving cats in traps pre and post surgery to recovery area and from and to trappers vehicles.

Assembly line: cleaning litter paper, debris from and washing traps, resetting traps with fresh paper. Assist to place cat in trap post op, applying topical flea meds, and locking traps for safe recovery.

Recovery room/paperwork monitor: Makes sure cats are waking up from anesthesia, processes medical paperwork and processes statistical data for clinic recaps.

Clean up crew: assembly line sanitizing and breakdown, and sweeping and mopping recovery room.

Additionally, sometimes we assist colony caretakers in transportation of cats to and from clinics.
